PRINTABLE PDFS OF PROJECTS BY COUNTY NOW AVAILABLE

In November 2015, Gov. Bill Haslam released a list of 765 new road projects across the state that would help address our roads' growth and the safety of Tennessee roads. These projects – not yet approved or funded by the state legislature – are valued at \$5.3 billion. The new projects are in addition to the existing list of committed but unfunded projects, valued at \$6.1 billion.
